

The Six Minimum Requirements for Grant Eligibility for Country Coordinating Mechanisms

1. CCM members representing the non-government sectors must be selected/elected by their own sector(s) based on a documented, transparent process, developed within each sector.
2. The Global Fund requires all CCMs to show evidence of membership of people living with and/or affected by the diseases
3. CCMs are required to put in place and maintain a transparent, documented process to: Solicit and review submissions for possible integration into the proposal;
4. CCMs are required to put in place and maintain a transparent, documented process to: Ensure the input of a broad range of stakeholders, including CCM members and non-members, in the proposal development and grant oversight process.
5. CCMs are required to put in place and maintain a transparent, documented process to nominate the Principal Recipient(s) and **oversee program implementation.**
6. When the PRs and Chair or Vice Chairs of the CCM are the same entity, the CCM must have a written plan in place to mitigate against this inherent conflict of interest.
